

This paint protection product 'has you covered'



Everyone wants to keep their car looking showroom new. Final Coat says it has the product that can do just that, It's called Xzilon Molecular Adhesion.

"Xzilon is a true sealant. It forms a layer of protection on the cars finish that won't melt," explains Randy Peek, whose company, Final Coat Inc., markets the product.

Peek says Xzilon forms a barrier against UV, bird droppings, tree sap, road tar and road salt among other terms. And it also protects against discolouration and loss of gloss or fading.

Although the product may go on by hand like a wax, he says Xzilon is not a wax; wax washes off. Xzilon doesn't. It bonds with the vehicle's finish to provide "not only a lasting protective barrier but also a smooth, easy-to-clean surface that resists adhesion."

Applying Xzilon isn't hard, he says. No equipment needed. All it takes are the two cloths supplied.

Final Coat staff will teach service department staff how to apply the product.

"If the dealership technician we trained to apply Xailon moves on, we will train a replacement," he says.

The product comes with a 10-year new-car warranty underwritten by RSA Canada. There's a seven-year warranty available for used cars. And there's no need to reapply, he says

Peeks says the product was developed with the aircraft industry in mind. It extends paint life and prevent corrosion on polished and unpolished bare metal surfaces and is heat resistant to 450 degrees E It's in use on Boeing, Douglas and Bombardier aircraft.

"If paint is sprayed on a surface treated with Xzilon, it will repel the spray," he says.
